TEAM EVENT - MIXED (Subject to a minimum number of entries, at least 6 teams from 4 different NPC's) – Max 2 teams per NPC.

#### ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

- Hold a valid IPCAS License for the 2010/2011 season.
- All athletes have to be **previously** IPCAS Internationally Classified. **There will be no Classification at the WCH for New athletes.**
- **Age Limit:** as per IPCAS Regulation 304.5

- **IPCAS Points Limit**

**1) Speed Events**

- For Downhill, athletes must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Downhill IPCAS list **or** below 90 IPCAS points in the Super-G IPCAS list;
- For Super-G, athletes must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Super-G or Downhill IPCAS lists;
- For Super Combined, athletes must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Super-Combined, Super-G or Downhill IPCAS lists; if the SC comprises a DH race, the criteria for DH entry apply.

**2) Technical Events / Team Event**

- For Slalom, Giant Slalom and Team Event, athletes must be below 200 IPCAS points in either one of the SL/GS IPCAS points list.

**The IPCAS Points referred to above will be from the 5 January 2011 list.**

**NPC DELEGATION QUOTA FORMULA**

Teams shall be allowed to enter the following number of staff per athlete:

From 1 to 2 athletes            3 Staff, plus VI-guides

From 3 to 5 athletes           5 Staff, plus VI-guides

From 6 to 10 athletes        11 Staff, plus VI-guides

Above 10 athletes 1 additional staff to every 2 athletes (rounded up)

Extra Staff permitted: Chef de Mission and one (1) Team Doctor
