

Participation in IPC Alpine Skiing Competitions 2010/2011

1) IPC Alpine Skiing World Championships

The Qualification Criteria for the 2011 IPCAS WCH will be published separately

2) IPC Alpine Skiing World Cups

- For Downhill, athletes must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Downhill IPCAS list **or** below 90 IPCAS points in the Super-G IPCAS list;
- For Super-G, athletes must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Super-G **or** Downhill IPCAS lists;
- For Super Combined, athletes must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Super-Combined, Super-G or Downhill IPCAS lists; if the SC comprises a DH race, the criteria for DH entry apply.
- For Slalom and Giant Slalom, athletes must be below 100 IPCAS points **in the respective** discipline's IPCAS points list.

3) IPC Alpine Skiing European Cups

IPCAS European Cups will have a maximum field size of 140 athletes (men and women together per discipline).

- For Downhill, athletes must be below 200 IPCAS points from the Downhill or Super-G IPCAS Points
- For Super-G, athletes must be below 200 IPCAS points from the Super-G or Downhill IPCAS lists;
- For Super Combined, athletes must be below 200 IPCAS points from the Super-Combined, Super-G or Downhill IPCAS lists;
- For Slalom and Giant Slalom, athletes must be below 200 IPCAS points in **either of the two** discipline's IPCAS points list (*)

(*)As of season 2011/2012 the applied EC criteria will be the following:

- For Slalom and Giant Slalom the athlete must be below 200 IPCAS points **in the respective** discipline's IPCAS Points' lists;
