

Participation in IPC Alpine Skiing Competitions

1) IPC Alpine Skiing World Championships

2) IPC Alpine Skiing World Cups

- For Speed and Super Combined Disciplines the athlete must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Downhill or Super-G IPCAS lists;
- For Technical Disciplines the athlete must be below 100 IPCAS points respectively from the Slalom IPCAS list and below 100 IPCAS points from Giant Slalom IPCAS list.

Rule 1263.1 Printing Deadlines and Validity of the Individual List

Printing will be each First of the Month. To calculate the points will be used all results till the 15th of each month. This list will give the start order for all races up to Level 1.

The athlete meeting the WC Qualification Criteria at the beginning of the season is qualified for all World Cups that entire season.

3) IPC Alpine Skiing European Cups

** Each athlete must be IPC internationally classified (in accordance with the IPC Classification Code) before starting at an IPC Alpine Skiing World Cup and World Championships.*

** For races of level 2, 3 or 4, if the jury is uncertain of the athlete's classification and the athlete has not been internationally classified the athlete must start in the higher class possible.*

The IPCAS STC recommends the Organizers for EC races for 2008/2009 to keep a maximum field size of 140 athletes per race. Each LOC can potentially set the cut to the entries received if a bigger field size can not be handled.

For season 2009/2010 the IPCAS STC will implement the 140 field size for the EC races using the IPCAS Points List and a Point Limit of 200 IPCAS Points published on the 1st of the month of the specific race/races.
