

## Participation in IPC Alpine Skiing Competitions 2009/2010 (Updated 30 November 2009)

### 1) IPC Alpine Skiing Paralympic Winter Games

### 2) IPC Alpine Skiing World Cups

- For Downhill events, the athlete must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Downhill **or** Super-G IPCAS lists;

- For Super-G events, the athlete must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Super-G IPCAS list;

- For Super Combined events, the athlete must be below 120 IPCAS points from the Super-Combined **or** Super-G lists;

- For Technical Disciplines the athlete must be below 100 IPCAS points **respectively** from the Slalom IPCAS list and below 100 IPCAS points from Giant Slalom IPCAS list.

**The athlete meeting the WC Qualification Criteria at the beginning of the season is qualified for all World Cups that entire season.**

### 3) IPC Alpine Skiing European Cups

IPCAS European Cups will have a maximum field size of 140 athletes (men and women together per event).

- For Speed and Super Combined Disciplines the athlete must be below 200 IPCAS points from the Super-G **or** Super Combined IPCAS lists;

- For Technical Disciplines the athlete must be below 200 IPCAS points from the Slalom **or** Giant Slalom IPCAS lists.

**NPC from the Organizing Committee will have a right to 5 Wild Cards for EC races.**
