

# IPC Alpine skiing Equipment Testing Protocol

Season 2011/2012

## Ski Stand Height

Ski stand height is measured by one of two methods:

If a measurement block that has been approved by the IPCAS STC is available the following method is used;

The block must be able to slide onto to ski at the boot contact point of the rear binding.

The block must be able to span the space from the ski running surface to the point of contact of the ski boot on the binding with out having to exert force to apply the device.

If a measurement block is not available than a digital calliper capable of measuring to at least 0.1 mm accuracy will be used to measure the stand as described in #1.

If the measurement block is used and cannot either with force or it will not fit at all a digital calliper measurement is required. This is carried out as described in #2.

Equipment that is not to be within the rules must be confiscated and kept until the Jury makes a final decision regarding disqualification.
